

## **Assistant Teaching Professor in Food Supply Medicine (NTT)**

The University of Missouri College of Veterinary Medicine, Department of Veterinary Medicine and Surgery, seeks applications for a **non-tenure track faculty position in food supply veterinary medicine**. This is a full time / 12 month appointment. This position is eligible for University benefits. ### **Job Description**

Appointment's primary focus is in food animal medicine and surgery, with majority of time dedicated to in-house clinical service. In addition, the successful candidate will:

- Contribute to our caseload-based clinical curriculum. Clinical teaching and service will primarily involve in-hospital food animal service
- Interact with the animal-owning public, referring veterinarians, students, commodity groups, extension faculty, animal science faculty, and the Missouri Department of Agriculture
- Share with other faculty and house officers in after-hours call
- Share responsibility for training interns, residents and graduate students
- Participate in clinical / production based research

Didactic teaching, outreach, or administrative service will make up the remainder of the appointment.

### **Qualifications and Preferences**

Diplomate status in the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine Large Animal Internal Medicine specialty is preferred, but other specialists such as Diplomates of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons, American Board of Veterinary Practitioners, or European College of Bovine Health Management will be considered.

### **Selection Criteria**

Candidates will be assessed based upon educational and professional achievement. License to practice in State of Missouri, BNDD and Federal Accreditation, and valid driver's license are required for the successful candidate to carry out assigned duties. Clinical experience, communication skills, and letters of reference will all be considered in selection of a candidate. The potential for the candidate to work within the framework of the food supply medicine section will also be assessed, as will specialty training and teaching experience.
