Respiratory Potpourri

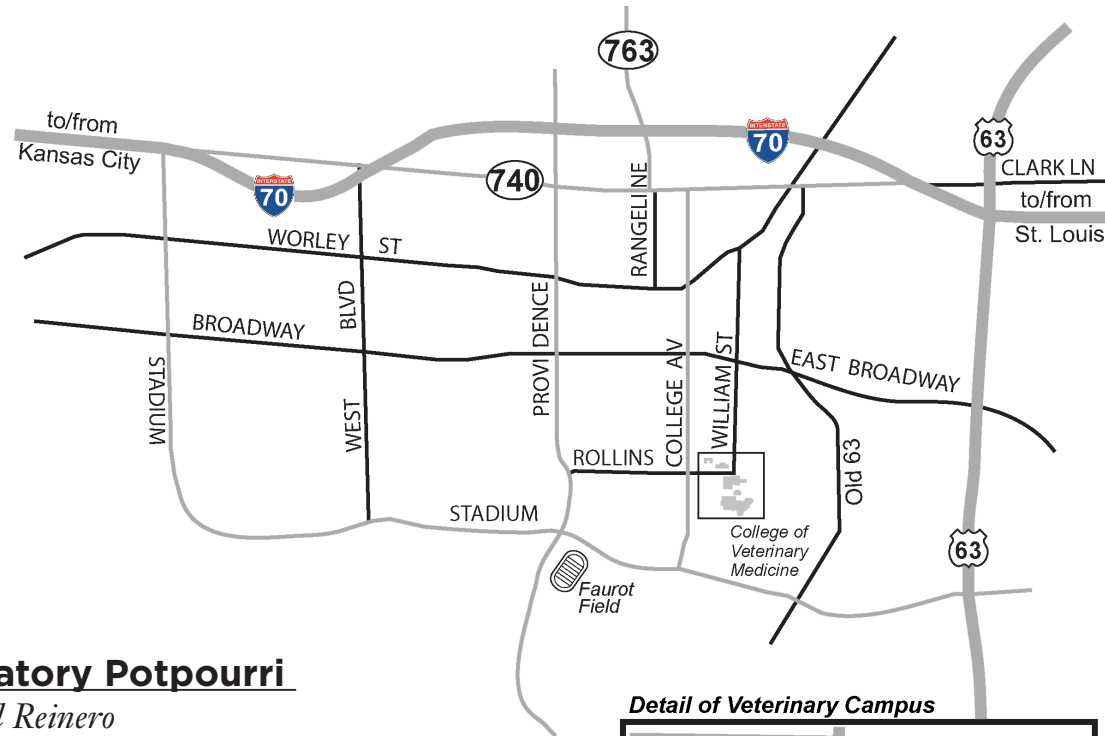
Dr. Carol Reinero

A series of clinical cases of dogs and cats presenting with a spectrum of respiratory disorders will be used to illustrate diagnosis and management of these conditions.

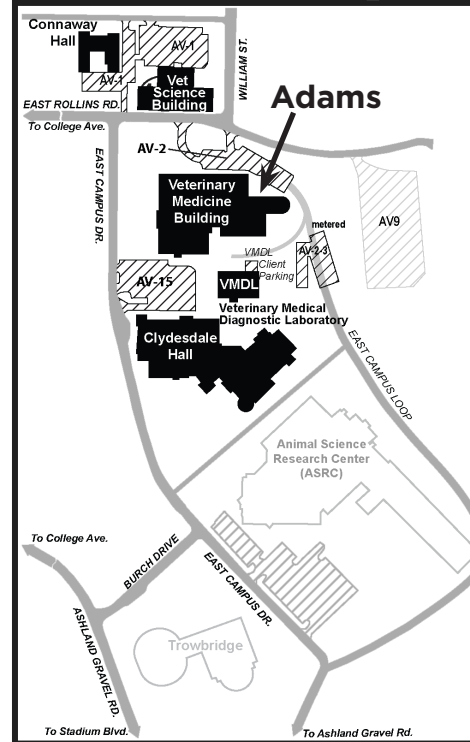
Update on Cardiopulmonary-cerebral Resuscitation
