For DVMs:

- In the bonus lab session Sunday afternoon, to the extent possible, lab attendee's requests to learn specific procedures will be accommodated.

- Attendance at the lectures is required for entry into the wet labs.
- We will provide you access to electronic files including "how to" guides for the procedures we will cover in the tech and veterinarian labs (e.g., maintaining equipment, sharpening equipment, taking and interpreting oral radiographs, cleaning, polishing and charting, saving fractured teeth, extracting teeth, raising flaps and common periodontal surgery procedures).

- This may be the last time Dr. Meadows runs this event; Dr. Brophy anticipates continuing the tradition after this year.
